



HARDENED LUXURY

Real off-road abilities and strength combine with plenty of comforts in this camper trailer

After a long day out on the tracks, the last thing you need when you just want to get some sleep is a wet bed. Travelling with a camper that requires minimal set-up and a combined living and sleeping area is a truly valuable asset.

The Vista RV Crossover is the flagship model of Vista RV's range, which also includes the TVK. It was designed to fill a space in the camper trailer market by offering a hard roof and

long list of inclusions normally reserved for caravans, yet in an off-road ready camper trailer package.

Utilising Vista's exclusive MS suspension system as its base, the Vista RV Crossover is capable of taking on virtually anything that your tow vehicle can. A café dinette that can quickly and easily transform into a queen bed is the centrepiece of the interior, which also includes plenty of storage, electrical gear and a Waeco fridge.



1 Butterfly latches help to secure the Vista RV Crossover when it's in transit. Between the dust and water seals and this latching system, you can rest easy knowing your gear inside will stay clean and dry.



2 Vista RV Crossover aimed to build the Crossover as efficiently as possible, so this nose cone was included to minimise wind resistance. It also doubles as a storage locker to hold all of your bigger pieces of gear.



3 Construction and finish on the Vista RV Crossover is second to none. The kitchen is a great example of the engineering involved in the build – there are a total of three work surfaces, two drawers and a stove!

4 The AT35 articulated coupling is secured by a locking pin to avoid any unwanted de-hitches. The system provides a full range of motion and allows the camper to move independently of your 4WD. Electric brakes are also included to help give you total control in all situations. They're also modified to ensure they stand up to harsh off-road life.



5 Australia is a great country to travel in, but there's no denying it can get pretty hot. The fan that's included on the Vista RV Crossover keeps the interior cool while you're trying to get some sleep.



6 240V outlets offer some reassurance that you can keep your phones, laptops or DVD players charged. It's great to have a power source such as this one organised so you can keep the kids entertained with a DVD when things slow down.



7 Once you've had some rest for the night the bed converts into a dining area. This is ideal for colder climates or wet weather, where it's not always practical to eat outside.

8 An 80L fridge/freezer is included to keep your food and drinks cool while you're travelling. It's important to have a reliable source of cooling on board to ensure food doesn't perish, so Vista RV Crossover made a great choice going for a reputable brand such as Waeco to supply the unit.



9 240V outlets offer some reassurance that you can keep your phones, laptops or DVD players charged. It's great to have a power source such as this one organised so you can keep the kids entertained with a DVD when things slow down.



10 The underside of the Vista RV Crossover is where the unit really shines. The heavy-duty chassis and on-board water tank, which is permanently plumbed in, and independent suspension set a high benchmark that the body of the Crossover follows closely.
